# 2017 PREVENTIVE DRUG LIST

Preventive medications are used for the prevention of conditions such as high blood pressure, high cholesterol, diabetes, asthma, osteoporosis, heart attack, stroke and prenatal nutrient deficiency.

You may not have to pay a copay, a coinsurance (the percentage you pay after you meet your deductible) and/or a deductible (the amount you pay before your plan starts to pay) for preventive medications.

Please check your plan's prescription drug list and plan documents to understand how your plan covers preventive medications. Generic medications have the same active ingredients, dosage form, quality and strength, as their brand-name counterparts and may provide additional savings for you.
